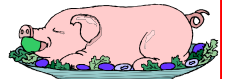

NEW Pump Station at Zanes Landing now in Operation (NEEDS USE):

The city of Zanesville is encouraging use of the station so that they will be able to show that there is a decent boat population & activity & therefore a need for additional public docks at Zanes Landing. The ZYC will have 100 tokens that can be used to operate the pump. These tokens are free of charge & are being used as a monitoring system right

now to gage the usage. **(See any of our Dock Masters or Trustees for tokens. We can have an unlimited amount but we must use the ones we have to acquire more...use being the key word here.....so don't horde them...use them.)**

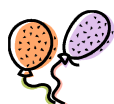

Repair & New Boat Propellers:

As a ZYC Member you can have your prop repaired at a discount rate. A significant savings over normal retail prices. We have forms at clubhouse & on our website. You must mention you are a ZYC member & may need to show your card. An example of average aluminum mid size repair costs: Retail \$102.00 ...ZYC cost "NET" would be \$81.00.

? TRASH POLICY AT ZYC ?

ALL TRASH IS TO BE PUT IN THE **DUMPSTER**....THAT'S RIGHT..THE **DUMPSTER**. EVER WONDER WHY WE DO NOT HAVE TRASH CONTAINERS ON DOCKS OR AT TOP OF STEPS?? THIS WOULD CAUSE ANIMAL PROBLEMS & OVERFLOWS OF TRASH. THE CONTAINERS IN CLUBHOUSE & ON PATIO ARE FOR PRIVATE PARTIES OR ZYC EVENTS & ARE TO BE CLEANED OUT *IMMEDIATELY* AFTER PARTY TO PREVENT BUG PROBLEMS & FRUIT FLY PROBLEMS. HELP KEEP THE ZYC CLEAN & PUT ALL TRASH IN THE **DUMPSTER**. ALUMINUM CANS CAN BE PLACED IN DESIGNATED CONTAINERS.

DOCKED BOATS: NOTE: All boaters who dock are highly encouraged to carry your own boat insurance. ZYC insurance does not cover boats on docks. Next year members who docks will be required to sign a dock lease agreement.
